GRANT STORY: CHILD CARE INITIATIVE

Revolutionizing Child Care through Community-Centered Child Care Solutions

Quality affordable and reliable child care is crucial to the vitality of our local economy and the well-being of families in our area. The scarcity of child care options in Emmet County affects us all, no matter if you're the parent of young children, someone without kids, or an empty nester. According to a recent survey conducted on behalf of North Central Michigan College's (NCMC) Child Care Initiative, 72% of Emmet County employers said their employees struggle to find suitable child care arrangements. Lack of child care results in lost work hours and diminishes the availability of essential services within our community.

The Community Foundation recognizes that addressing the challenges facing our child care system requires collaboration. Over the past two years, the Community Foundation has committed \$100,000 to support NCMC's Child Care Initiative. This initiative gathered community input to inform the development of innovative child care solutions. Informed by our community's feedback, NCMC is now working to implement a child care business model that ensures living wages and benefits for the child care workforce and creates connections between child care providers, parents, and employers. The ultimate goal is to expand access to quality affordable child care for working families in our region.

GRANT STORY: ENVIRONMENT

Celebrating the Maple River's Revival

The Maple River is a classic cold-water river that meanders 55 miles through the hardwood and pine forest of Emmet County, emptying into Burt Lake. Yet nearly a century of habitat destruction caused by man-made dams, undersized road crossings, and culverts was threatening native species and destroying stream quality. In 1999, the Conservation Resource Alliance (CRA) launched the Free Spanning the Maple River initiative to restore the river's free flow and rich habitat. After nearly two decades of diligent work – including stream crossing replacements, habitat restoration, and a major dam removal – CRA proudly completed the final crossing in 2023 with a timber bridge at Douglas Lake Road. Maple River is the first major river in the United States to be liberated entirely from such obstructions.

This initiative marks a historic milestone as the first-ever free span of a major river in the United States. Already, this initiative has yielded significant economic and ecological benefits, and its positive impact on the region will continue to unfold in the years ahead.

The Community Foundation has been a steadfast partner in this restoration journey since 2006. The Foundation's enduring commitment to this work began with a \$2,000 grant for the Robinson Road crossing, and now totals nearly \$75,000 in grant funding for the project. These funds, alongside 45 other partners and funders, empowered this \$10 million effort to completion. The project's impact will be felt for generations, improving habitat for native fish species and potentially allowing for the reintroduction of the Arctic Grayling, a native fish species wiped out in the 1930s. The collaboration and financial support have not only restored the Maple River but have also created a replicable model for river restoration across the Great Lakes watershed.

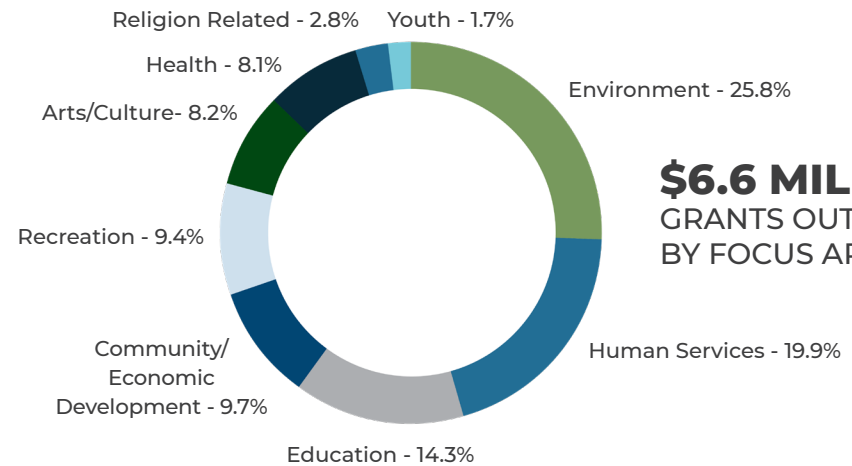
Honoring Stewardship

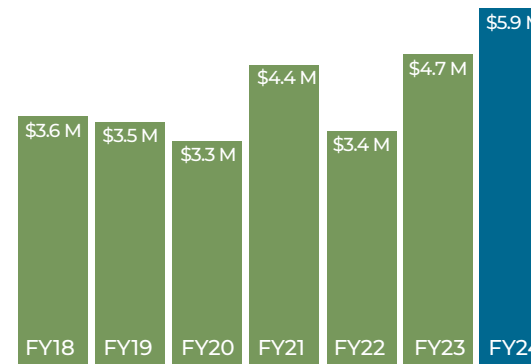

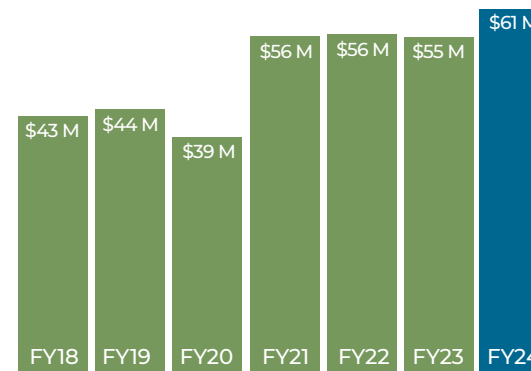
